Security Incentive Scheme Round 6

Working together for a safe community

This Scheme assists residents to improve the level of security within and around their home.

Am I eligible?

To be eligible for the Scheme, you must comply with the following:

- Be a resident within the City of Canning.
- Be the property owner, or agent authorised to act on their behalf, or a tenant with a signed consent from one of these.

How does the security incentive scheme work?

- Residents/Property Owners are entitled to make one application per financial year.
- Applicants can install multiple security items in their home, however the total rebate amount will be capped at \$300 per applicant, per financial year, or \$400 for those holding a valid Pensioner Concession, Health Care or WA Seniors Card.
- Once the security items have been purchased and/or installed, your application will be assessed and, if approved, the rebate amount will be deposited into your nominated bank account.
- Rebate amounts offered will depend on the item/s installed. See table below.

The table below shows the maximum rebate amount available for each item. See the FAQs at canning.wa.gov.au/saferhomes for more information.

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Conditions:

- All devices requiring hard-wired electrical supply, including sensor lights, must be installed by a registered electrician.
- Security screen doors, window screens & roller shutters must be installed by a licensed security installer.
- Applications received with a tax invoice and/or receipt dated prior to 12 May 2024 will not be accepted.
- The City provides no guarantee that a rebate will be provided to all eligible applicants if the allocated budget is expended prior to the end of the financial year.
- The City of Canning are not responsible for any data or other information related to this application that may be lost, damaged or delayed as a result of any computer software, hardware malfunction or postal service delay.

The City strongly encourages the installation of all security devices be completed by a registered business with a valid Security Installers License and those installing public facing CCTV to register with WA Police Cam-Map at cam-map.wa.police.wa.gov.au.

How do I apply for a Security Incentive Scheme rebate?

STEP 1:

- Before purchasing and/or installing your security item/s, read this application form in full and take a look at the Frequently Asked Questions at canning.wa.gov.au/saferhomes.
- Ensure you receive a fully itemised tax invoice showing the account has been paid in full (\$0.00 balance) and/or a copy of the itemised receipt showing proof of purchase.
 - If installing equipment requiring qualified personnel, ensure a list of relevant trade licenses is included on the invoice.
- If equipment installed is DIY, a photo showing the installed equipment must be attached.

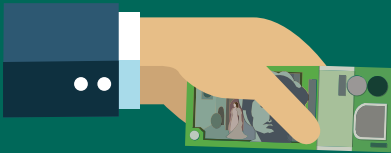
STEP 2:

- Complete this application form in full.
 - Attach the required documentation:
 - Copy of the itemised receipt showing proof of purchase (\$0.00 balance).
 - Bank statement header of your nominated bank account for deposit of rebate.
 - Copy of Pensioner, Health care or Seniors Card (if applicable).
- Submit documents:

 - In person: City of Canning Administration, 1317 Albany Highway, Cannington WA.

The City will review your application and advise you of the outcome, including the subsidy rebate amount in writing.

- Application completed in full (this form!).
A copy of the PAID itemised tax invoice (\$0.00 balance) from the security provider and/or itemised proof of purchase.
- If installing equipment requiring qualified personnel, ensure a list of relevant trade licenses is included on the invoice.
- A copy of a bank statement header including the Account Holder Name, BSB and Account Number of the nominated account for deposit of rebate.
- A copy of any concession cards (if applicable).
